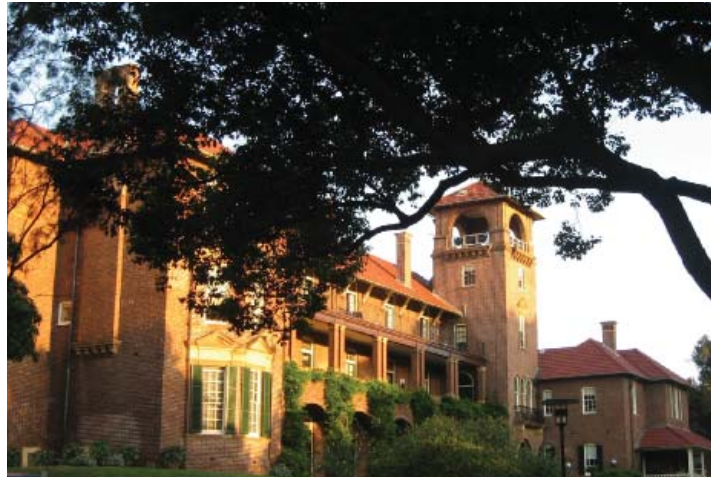
The Women's College, within The University of Sydney, is pleased to announce that it is hosting the 2010 Women's Education Worldwide Conference.
