NOMINATION INFORMATION

Award Categories and Criteria

1) The Women's College Alumna Award

A Women's College Alumna, who has demonstrated over a sustained period of time one or more of the following:

- a) Outstanding professional achievements, for instance:
 - Recognition as a leader/expert in her field
 - Significant achievement(s) throughout her career
- b) Inspirational leadership in the field, for instance:
 - Mentoring employees/younger people
 - Initiating/encouraging successful innovative systems/practices
 - Demonstrating significant creativity or vision
 - Advocacy of equal opportunities, anti-discrimination etc.
 - Encouraging corporate philanthropy and community support
- c) Other contributions, for instance:
 - Engaging in personal philanthropy
 - Community leadership or service
 - Personal achievement outside of her professional arena
 - Service to The Women's College

2) The Women's College Young Alumna Award

A Women's College Alumna, under 40 years at the close of nominations, who can be shown to have made a significant impact in her field of endeavour. This can be demonstrated by, for instance:

- Contributions to a profession or community
- Successful creation of innovative practices
- Emerging leadership in an area

3) The Women's College Alumna Community Achievement Award

A Women's College Alumna who has demonstrated exceptional service to the community in, for instance:

- Dedication of significant time and resources to community and/or charity activities
- Successful development and implementation of community support activities

Nominations

Nominations must be made by a member of The Women's College Alumnae.

The nomination should indicate why the Nominator considers the Nominee worthy of the award.

The nomination should be no more than **four** pages in length including the Nomination Form Front Page – see below. It should address the criteria for selection clearly and succinctly. A short resume of up to **three** pages may be appended to the nomination to illustrate the Nominee's career and achievements. Other appendices will not be accepted.

The Nominee must be a member of The Women's College Alumnae.

The Nominee must be willing to be nominated and her assistance may be sought in compiling the nomination.

The Nominee must be available to receive the award.

The Nominee is requested to be available to make a short statement on film that will be shown at the presentation of the awards. The College will contact the Nominee and be responsible for making the film.

Selection of Award Winners

The Selection Committee will consist of members of the Nominations Committee of The Women's College

Presentation of Awards

The awards will be announced and presented at the Louisa MacDonald Dinner and Oration on 27 May 2011.

Closing Date

The closing date for receipt of nominations is **Monday 18 April 2011**
